Who can sponsor under NRI Seat:

Sl. No.	Eligibility
1	Mother or Father of the student
2	Real Brother and Sister of the student
3	Real Brother and sister of Father or Mother i.e real uncle and real aunt of the student
4	Father and Mother of Father or Mother of the student i.e. Grand parents
5	First degree – paternal and maternal cousins of the student.

Important Note: NRI Applicants:

- 1) The person sponsoring should hold NRI status and residing abroad and such person should have looked after the student as the guardian. A Notarized Affidavit to that effect should be submitted at the time of admission on a twenty rupee stamp paper.
- 2) NRI quota shall include Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)
- 3) Course Fee as mentioned in the schedule should be paid in US Dollars. If It is paid in INR, then it should be paid through the NR Account of the sponsorer

Counseling Procedure:

A) Come prepared for Counseling: The following original documents are to be submitted for verification during Counseling:

- 1) NEET 2017 Score Card
- 2) NEET 2017 (UG) Rank Card
- 3) NEET Hall Ticket / Admit Card
- 4) S.S.C. / 10th Standard Statement of Marks
- 5) H.S.C. / 12th Standard / Equivalent Examination Statement of Marks
- 6) Leaving / Transfer Certificate
- 7) Bonafide and character certificate from Head of Institution last attended.
- 8) Certificate of Age (S.S.C. or 10th Passing Certificate / Valid passport)
- 9) Caste & Caste validity certificate (by candidates belonging to all Backward class)
- 10) Migration Certificate

- 11) Aadhar card photo copy
- 12) Six passport size colour photographs
- 13) Demand Draft of Tuition Fees
- 14) Three self attested photo copies separate sets of above all documents as per above sequence.

In addition to the above, the NRI Applicants would have to submit the following additional documents.

- 1) Nationality Certificate/Valid Passport/Domicile Certificate Sponsor's resident certificate issued by the Embassy of the country complying the Income Tax Rules
- 2) Passport (In case of Foreign National/Wards of person of Indian origin/Wards of NRI)
- 3) Sponsor's passport/VISA/Resident VISA
- 4) Citizenship of the candidate if holding OCI/PIO
- 5) Income Tax Documents required as per the Income Tax Act 1961 of the sponsorer
- 6) The degrees/Certificates of the candidates must have been recognized and approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) if the qualifying examination is other than the 10 + 2 of India.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

There will be active verification of the NEET All India Rank (UR) submitted by the candidate with the information available in the NEET website (cbseresults.nic.in). Candidate whose NEET All India rank does not match with the information in the NEET website will be disqualified from the counseling process.

B) On the day of Counseling:

The physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is mandatory.

- a) Only the candidate & one parent will be allowed into the counseling hall

- b) Candidate should sign the attendance register to mark their presence and fill the registration form available at the registration counter.
- c) Candidates will be called as per their NEET All India (UR) Rank 2017 for document verification. Successful candidates will be allotted seats according to their All India NEET (UR) rank and number of seats available. Such candidates should produce their original documents for verification and pay the first year fees at the time of counseling. SSAHE will not entertain any requests for extension in this regard.

Absence of the candidate at the indicated reporting time and date will result in the instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for a seat.

The choice of course/campus made by the candidate is final and binding and cannot be altered later under any circumstances. Once candidates get admitted to MBBS / BDS course cannot withdraw / cancel under any circumstances.

C) After Admission:

- a) Admission order/Provisional Admission Order and receipt/s for the payment made will be given to the candidate on completion of the admission process.
- b) Candidates who require hostel facility should report to Chief Warden of the allotted campus for hostel enrollment. Hostel will be allotted on payment of hostel fees only.
- c) Candidates should report to the allotted college on or before the reporting date mentioned in the admission order.

Annual Fee Structure

Mode of Payment:

MBBS : The first year course fees (INR) should be paid by crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'Secretary, Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur payable at Tumkur.

BDS : The first year course fees (INR) should be paid by crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of ' Secretary, Sri Siddhartha Dental College, Tumkur payable at Tumkur.

The payment can also be made by transfer of equivalent Indian Rupees from the NR account of the parent. However, this should be supported by a letter from the Banker stating that the amount is from the NR account.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Part payment or payment in installment is not permitted. Non-payment of the first year fees on the day of counseling will result in instantaneous forfeiture of seat.
