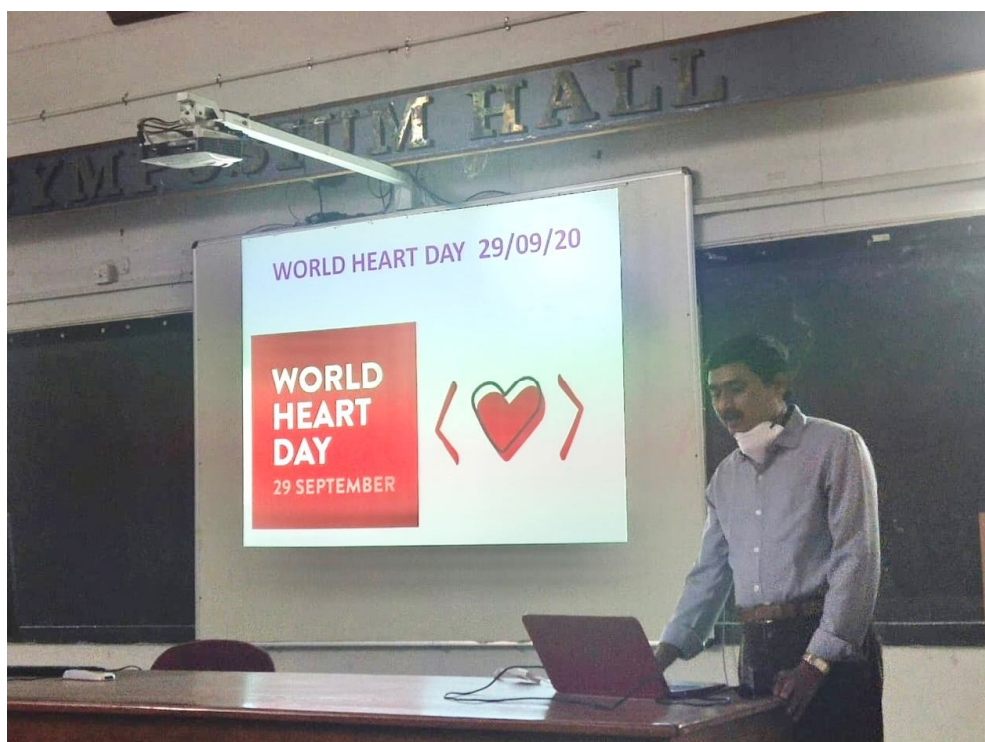
The department of General Medicine, SSMC, Tumkur in association with Academic and Scientific committee celebrated World Heart Day on 12-10-2020.
