MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING / AGREEMENT

1. This Memorandum of Undertaking is made on this day, 17th February 2022 between Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education, herein referred as "SSAHE" having its office at B.H. Road, Agalakote, Tumkur - 572 107, KARNATAKA, INDIA.

Argaav Training Solutions which is a wing of **Argaav Healthcare Pvt. Ltd.** herein refer to as **"Argaav"** having its office at 5th Cross, G K W LAYOUT, Vijaya Nagara Bangalore-560 040, KARNATAKA, INDIA

- 2. The cause for this MoU is signed for Pharmacovigilance Training under the SSAHE, initially program will be launched as "Pharmacovigilance Certification Program" which will be of 3 months (12 weeks) for students or graduates of Medical and life sciences.
- 3. Whereas SSAHE is desirous of undertaking a joint project for the training and certification in collaboration with Argaav, the two parties of this Memorandum of Understanding, with the intention of both being legally bound, accept the following terms and conditions:

4. Coordination and Contact Points

- a. Both SSAHE and Argaav for coordination on broad policy issues and matters related to centralized operations;
- b. SSAHE and Argaav for all training-related matters which includes screening and enrollment of students, training (Online regular training sessions and Offline contact classes), assessment and certification and, placement assistance - up to 3 interviews.
- c. SSAHE for all operational matters which include providing venues (contact classes and assessments), releasing program notifications, admission, certification of eligible students.
- d. This program is not limited to SSAHE students or alumni; it is for all eligible students and graduates.

5. Responsibilities of SSAHE

SSAHE shall;



REALTHCARES

- a. Provide the required support to Argaav to run the training program.
- b. Roll out a notification for new training batches as and when required.
- c. Co-ordination between the interested candidates and counseling.
- d. Screening and Admission to the relevant training batches which includes providing application, maintaining financial accounts, remuneration to faculties, domain experts/consultants, marketing materials, and staff.
- e. Providing infrastructure to conduct classes, as and when required.
- Assessment and certification of the eligible students.

6. Responsibilities of Argaav:

Argaav shall:

- a. Providing faculties to conduct training sessions as per the batch schedule. Trainers with domain experience in the industry will be evaluated and deployed.
- b. Follow the course outline attached to this MoU (Attachment B), as may be amended from time to time.
- c. Device the screening test for prospective students.
- d. Co-ordination with SSAHE point of contact and faculties.
- e. Maintenance of student attendance, training sessions, and contact classes details.
- f. Providing status of each batch training to SSAHE point of contact.

7. Financials

To start with the first batch mutually it is decided as below; the financials can be restructured based on mutual agreement outside of this MOU.

8. Force Majeure

In the event of non-fulfillment of the contract terms and conditions due to any reason of force majeure namely fires, wars, riots, strikes, natural calamities, etc., neither SSAHE nor Argaav shall be held responsible for any loss or consequential loss.

9. Proprietary Rights

Argaav will retain all intellectual property rights to its study material, presentations, modules, and other program-related services, including without limitation, designs, drawings, patterns, plans, specifications, technology, technical data, software and information, technical processes and business methods, whether patentable or not, arising from the sale or other provision of goods and/or services to SSAHE.

This pharmacovigilance certified program will be exclusively with SSAHE only.

10. Improper Influence

The parties intend that no payments or transfers of value shall be made which have the purpose or effect of public or commercial bribery, or acceptance or acquiescence in extortion, kickbacks, or other unlawful or improper means of obtaining business.

11. Breach of Agreement

Both parties shall have the right to terminate the agreement, in case either of the parties fails to provide the services successfully as mentioned in this agreement, violates any of the clauses mentioned in this MOU, or exploits the students or misuses the partnership in any way.

12. Amendment to the Agreement

The obligation of SSAHE and Argaav have been outlined in this agreement. However, during the operation of the agreement, circumstances may arise that call for alteration or modifications of this Agreement. These modifications/alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.

It is recommended that the finance and other operational aspects are evaluated as and when based on the lessons learned to develop a robust program.

13. Period of Validity

This agreement shall be initially valid for two years from the date of signing the agreement and to be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both parties.

14. Arbitration

Any dispute arising about any aspect of this Agreement shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the Agreement.
